10.honor

sympathize: v. To feel for; to share in a feeling. (Example: I sympathize with my grieving friend whose grandfather just died.)

barge: v. To rudely interrupt or enter without permission. (*Example: Do not barge into my room without knocking!*)

n. A big, flat boat. (Example: The flat <u>barge</u> carried the boxes across the river.)

rowdy: *adj*. Behavior that is loud and aggressive. (*Example: The teacher insisted that the rowdy class settle down.*)

<u>retire</u>: v. To withdraw or leave, often from a job. (*Example: After working at the same job for forty years, he will <u>retire</u>.)*

snitching: v. To tell information about someone else. (Example: The tattletale is snitching on his sister.)

<u>villain</u>: *n*. A person who does evil things. (*Example: The hero outsmarted the evil villain*.)

<u>truant</u>: *n*. A person who stays away from school without permission. (*Example: The truant skips school all the time because he doesn't like to work.*)

adj. Absent from school without permission. (Example: The <u>truant</u> child had missed over 2 months of school.)

<u>sly</u>: adj. Mischievous, secretive, tricky. (Example: The <u>sly</u> foxed tricked the Gingerbread Man.)

<u>insane</u>: adj. Crazy, out of one's mind; utterly senseless. (Example: Your idea is completely <u>insane</u>!)

honor: *n*. Honesty, fairness, a high respect for. (Example: A man of honor always keeps his word.)

v. To treat with respect. (Example: We <u>honor</u> soldiers who have fought for us.)
