Best Christmas Pageant Ever Lesson 1 Vocabulary List

pageant: *n.* A show with participants or events; similar to a play. (*Example: I wanted to play the character of Mary in the Christmas pageant at church.*)

tradition: *n.* Something that is handed down from generation to generation. (*Example: My family's tradition on Thanksgiving is to eat a big meal together.*)

blackmail: *v.* To force someone to do something in order to get what you want by threatening to do or tell something. (*Example: I was blackmailed by my sister when she said she would tell my mom what I did unless I gave her my only piece of candy.*)

contribution: *n.* The act of giving something (money, time, supplies, etc) to something. (*Example: The missionaries' contribution to the village was to bring in medical supplies and food to the people.*)

hysterical: *adj.* Uncontrollably emotional, such as laughing, crying, etc. (*Example: The baby was hysterical when she dropped her bottle on the floor.*)
